

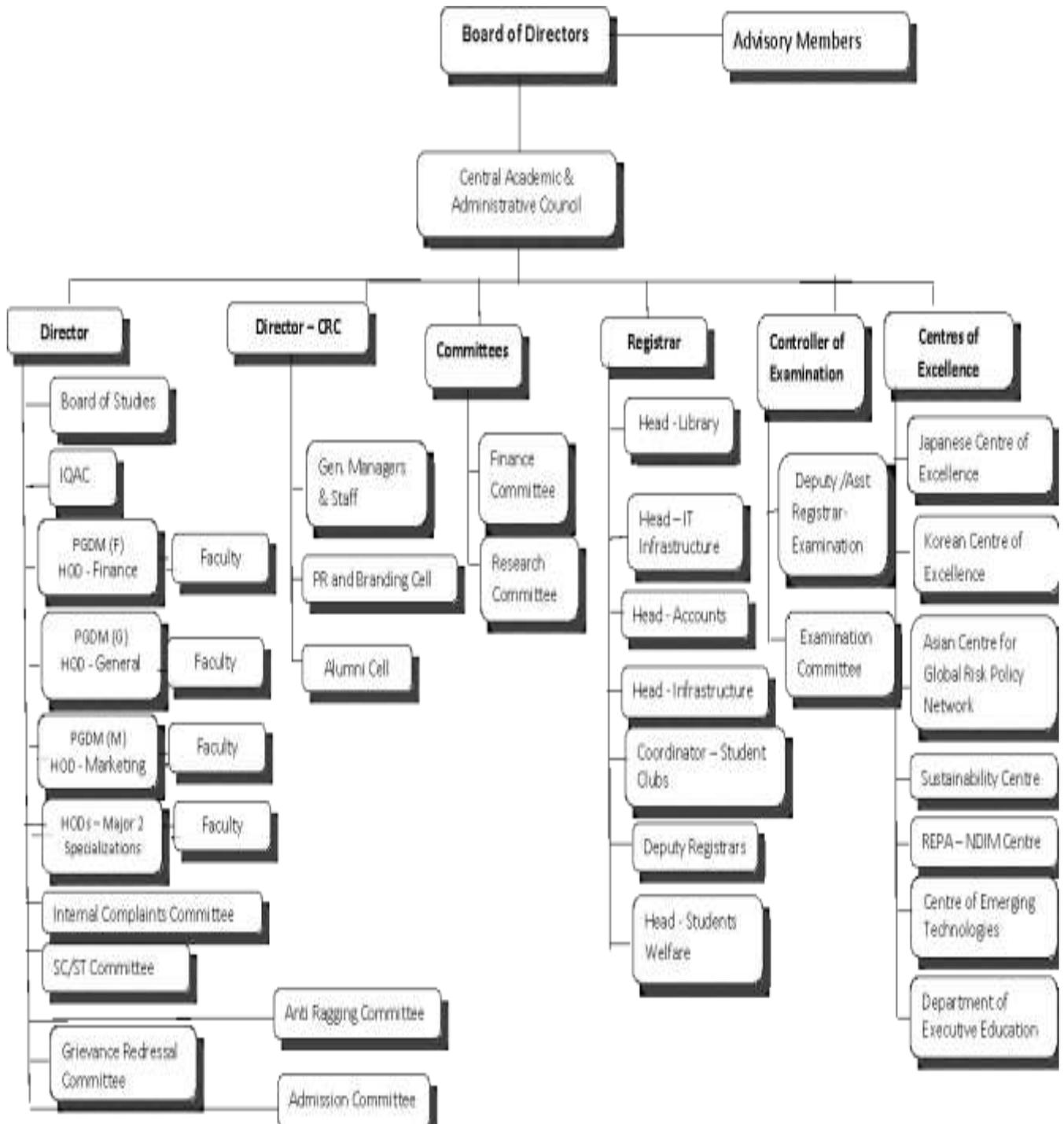

**Let's Eradicate the Menace of Ragging altogether**

In view of the Public Notices of the AICTE dated 17/06/2011 and 19/05/2012 for curbing the menace of Ragging. The Anti-Ragging Committee at New Delhi Institute of Management notified vide order No. NDIM/AICTE/ATR/270/2010 Dated: 02/06/2010 has been re-constituted due to change in the members of the committee as per regulations for prevention and prohibition of ragging in AICTE approved Technical Institutions vide No.37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01.07.2009. Third amendment in UGC regulations dated 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 expanded the definition of ragging by including as "Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic, identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background".

The new Committee also comprises of the members drawn from the Faculty, Senior Staff, Students, Media, NGO and Legal Arena.

This Committee shall oversee and provide assistance on rapid response basis in case of any ragging actively.
